At our local church, Cathie has been helping with the oversight of the children's ministry, and we are together leading a home group which meets at our house. In addition, David continues to preach occasionally in area churches. We are also exploring possibilities around one-off seminars, related to areas David teaches in, for churches in the near future.

Cathie has enjoyed continuing to build relationships with the female students, especially the new ones this term. She will also be starting to co-supervise a student doing an independent study on marriage and the family, looking particularly at Puritan teachings on the Christian family and home.
