Hérauts (GBU's annual conference) was very well-received by the 140 students and 37 ministry leaders (from 50 different churches in Belgium and neighbouring countries) who came to hear faithful Bible teaching and be equipped in evangelism

Michael was well enough to attend Hérauts on the day, got to chat with lots of students in French, and even got to help out at the bookstore well (i.e. Grivas-Allison happy place).

Rani was able to complete the 3-week integration course which is

Our new level of French has a focus on discussion/presentation based speaking . This is excellent timing for us as we look ahead to getting ministry ready by the summer .

Rani was able to give Keller's 'Prodigal God' to our neighbour Isabel She hasn't read it yet, but since then she and Rani have been on a few walks, during one of which Rani was able to pray with her (she loved it and said, "let's do a walk-and-pray again!")

In the midst of the discouragement of sickness, we received a **lovely and**encouraging CMS pastoral visit

All the documents required to renew our Belgian work-permit have now been sent off This is the first step in renewing our visas, and the result of much work on behalf of the GBU and CMS.
