This is a sister seminary that we have an on-going relationship with, and some of their students will do one semester at Tyndale. This year, all three of them were in my 'Ethics and worldview' class, and they both added a lot to our discussions, and seemed to really benefit from the course.

This month begins David's academic sabbatical at Tyndale--he will continue to lead his department and mentor students, but will not be teaching in favour of more time for research and preparation. He is looking forward to this season both as a 'catch-up' and an opportunity to become more effective in his teaching.

We feel that this is a real attack from the enemy as this church has grown dramatically the last several years, and God has been using them to bring many young adults to the Lord.

This is a big step of faith for us, so we are really praying that God will use it to help us build bridges in our community and draw some to Himself.
