Ministry Update

Summer has been a welcome change of pace after the busyness of the semester. June and July were mostly a time of catching-up and preparation with respect to David's teaching. In August, we returned to the South of France to serve at a family camp there. It was encouraging to be able to build on the connections that we made there. Cathie led art workshops once again, and helped with the younger children. David led the worship team and the daily Bible study with the teenagers. We were overjoyed to learn that last year two of the teenagers in the Bible study gave their lives to Christ during the camp!

We've welcomed the largest intake in recent memory, and are also switching over from a semester to trimester calendar system--and inaugurating a new curriculum! The incoming class has been a breath of fresh air, and we are particularly thankful for a larger-than usual group of Dutch students. David is carrying a particularly heavy load, as he's had to double-up this term since he'll be on academic sabbatical after the new year. As for our church plant, Via, we are continuing to meet weekly, and having a sweet time together, but are praying to God about the next steps, as the way forward is not entirely clear--please pray for unity of vision on the leadership team.

Cathie and the children have enjoyed a well-earned respite from school work over the summer. Annie attended a summer camp, and both Annie and Josiah were able to join a youth group for for a Christian festival for a few days in England. We are so thankful for these opportunities which seem to have been

significant for them, especially as they have quite a small circle of Christian friends. The school year is now off to a busy and productive start, which seems to involve increasingly more juggling as the kids get older. They are enjoying playing hockey once again, and Cathie is again helping to coach Annie's teamplease pray for God to use this to open doors for relationships. We also appreciate your prayers for a good friend who pastors a large international church in Amsterdam (the church we used to attend), and who is battling advanced cancer--their family is very close to ours, and this has been a big burden these last months.
