Dear Friends,

Have you been to a commissioning service for a CMS missionary?

CMS has recently sent Matt & Ellen Tyler and their children to Vanuatu, Taulama Siuhengalu to Vietnam and Kylie Zietsch back to South Africa. In the coming month, Brenton and Mel Kilby and their children will depart for Tanzania. For each of these missionaries, their commissioning services were important times of declaring and deepening partnership in the gospel, as we prepared to send them out for the sake of a world that knows Jesus.

As CMS partners with churches and individuals to set apart and send longterm cross-cultural gospel workers, we pray for mission partnerships to be personal and reciprocal. Our missionaries deeply value being known within the fellowship, enabled through the informed prayers and personalised practical care of their link churches and supporters. They also love getting to know those who send them with the gospel, both through purposeful investment of relationship on home assignment and ongoing contact while on location. These personal partnerships are expressed in a special way at commissioning services, where missionaries and supporters come together to send and be sent in prayerful dependence upon Christ. There is solemnity as we consider the mammoth task ahead, but also joy as we commit each other to the Lord of the Harvest who is sending out his workers.

Adam and Avril Friend, currently serving in Madagascar, liken a commissioning service to a wedding ceremony:

"A commissioning is a little like a wedding, just without the fancy dress. Promises are spoken, hands are joined (or rather laid on!), songs are sung and people are prayed for. Expect to be encouraged and expect to be a great encouragement."



Jason Veitch, Senior Minister at Campbelltown Anglican Churches likewise shares:

"Some of my greatest and most precious joys in ministry in Sydney have been attending CMS commissioning services and partnering with other churches to send workers around the globe. Having walked with Taulama over the years as he planned for long-term overseas ministry, it was a special privilege to join with others to pray for him as we sent him out."

Next time your church sends out a new missionary or commissions a returning missionary for another term of service, can I encourage you to be a part of their commissioning service? And will you please join me in praying that all of our missionaries will be strengthened to keep seeking God's glory, that Christ may be known in all the earth.


