Dear Friends,

Earlier this month we launched our annual CMS Lasting Hope Appeal. The appeal is an essential part of raising the funds needed to allow our missionaries to serve long-term in their locations.

This year we are seeking to raise \$640,000. This is an ambitious target, and one we cannot reach without your help. As missionary numbers have grown and the cost of sending and sustaining them rises, our total missionary budget has nearly doubled in the last five years.

To enable us to send missionaries for the long-term we urgently need your support.

Gillian Law has been serving in Italy for just over 10 years with university group, GBU. Over this time, she has mentored and walked alongside students, like Manuel. Now a trainee staff worker, he is leading Bible studies and discipling others while receiving the benefit of Gillian's mentoring.

"Gillian played a crucial role in my growth... She has helped me understand how to care for myself in my walk with God, and how to care for the students. The way she invests in me is shaping how I invest in them." We know that when students like Manuel are discipled well, they go on to disciple others and the impact ripples outwards. It makes a long-term impact!

Week of Prayer: Thank You for Praying With Us



Redeeming Babel: Why the Great Commission Still Matters

As churches increasingly focus their energy inward or just locally, Wei-Han Kuan (CMS Victoria Executive Director) reminds us that Jesus' call to make disciples of all nations hasn't changed. In his powerful article, first published by The Gospel Coalition Australia, Wei-Han challenges the popular idea that "the nations have come to us" means we no longer need to go. He argues instead that God's plan is bigger, richer, and more beautiful than that, one that includes redeeming Babel itself.

This vision of the church: diverse, united, global, isn't just about heaven someday. The redemption of Babel begins not just with crossing oceans but with opening our eyes to God's heart for all peoples.
