Tyndale and Ministry News

Before we went to the States, David was able to take part in a major conference co-organised by Tyndale, and featuring the author Carl Trueman, along with other speakers. David was scheduled to be the moderator for the panel discussions, but not to be a speaker. However, two days before the conference was set to start, one of the speakers

had to back out, and David was asked to fill in. The topic that he addressed 'Church discipline in the wake of the sexual revolution', was a sensitive one, but it was very well received. Furthermore, we received word from the Dutch co-organiser of the conference afterward that it had generated a tremendous response online afterwards. The whole conference was a huge encouragement, as it was attended by over 200 participants, and addressed an issue (secularism) which is very timely here in the Netherlands and in Europe. Thank you so much for your prayers for this event!

On our return to Europe, we were thankful to be able to serve at a family camp in France once again. Cathie again led in art workshops, and David led the daily youth Bible studies. Following this, David participated in the bi-annual Fellowship of European Evangelical Theologians (FEET) conference, representing Tyndale there and presenting a paper. It was a special conference this year, as it was co-sponsored by the European Evangelical Alliance, in celebration of the 50th anniversary of the Lausanne Conference, with the theme of the future of evangelicalism in Europe. David was encouraged that, although this was not initially planned, he was asked by the conference organisers afterwards if his paper could be included in the bound volume for the conference.

Back at in the Netherlands, we've been encouraged both by the new term and with the progress of our little church plant. David is teaching ethics and healthy church development again, continuing to lead the department, and also mentoring a group of students (something he missed last year, being away part of the year). There is a good spirit at the seminary, with lots of enthusiasm, though Tyndale continues to struggle financially right now. We continue to pray also for more European students (encouragingly, the number of Dutch students seems to be continually increasing, thanks to growing connections with the Dutch church).

Via Church was in low gear during the summer, but things are now picking up steam again. An older gentleman from the community has been attending regularly, even as he continues to attend the Dutch Reformed Church in the morning. A couple of weeks ago, he met an Indian man at that church, and invited him to come to Via in the afternoon. He has been attending ever since! We thank God for these connections, and pray that God would help us to draw more to Himself in our village.
