It has taken us a while to get the hang of hospitality here and to have the confidence to do it in French. However, we continue to be struck by how appreciative (and sometimes desperate) people seem to be to have a space to talk openly about life and faith and to be invited 'in' in a culture which can often feel quite closed. **We would love for you to pray that God would help us to grow our capacity for hospitality as a family,** and to bring us a steady stream of opportunities to reflect in ordinary ways the extraordinary welcome of Christ.



Thanks for praying for our friendship with James, Matt and Michaela (James is Alexi's bestie from school). In the last few months, they have become close friends and a real blessing to us as people we see regularly and can share life with. We talk often about faith together, as Mic is a strong Catholic. However, it can sometimes feel like we're using the 'same words' but talking about different things! **Please continue to pray for this family and for opportunities to speak of the close and confident relationship we can have with God through Christ.**



Over the last month Alexi made his Christmas choir debut (though no actual singing occurred). **We have also been invited to be more involved at church**, particularly through Bible-teaching on Sundays and in the women's ministry. We give thanks for the trust this represents and for the precious opportunity to open God's word with people. As always, **please pray for our courage and humility** as we continue to figure out the public-teaching space both culturally and language-wise. **But also for our wisdom and gentleness** as we navigate these conversations in a season where our church is feeling stretched without a pastor and with a number of people leaving over the last few months.
