## **Next Year**

As we have talk and prayed about next year, we have been convinced that its good to pursue opportunities for ministry amongst Nepali here in Sydney. A few interesting facts:

- According to the 2021 there were 123,000 Nepalese in Australia, with the largest population in Sydney
- Migrants coming into Australia in 2022-2023, saw Nepalese as the 4th largest group (after Indian, China and the Philippians)
- In the Sydney area the vast majority of Nepalese are in the 20-29 age group (29083 people, compared to only 4549 people in the 40-49 age group)

We have been having conversations about what this could look like, and in particular how it might be possible for Bijaya to do this either part time or full time. But right now its not at all clear.

<u>Give thanks</u> that many churches in Sydney are aware of the need for Nepali ministry, and that outreach that is already happening through ESL classes etc. <u>Give thanks</u> also for the small number of Nepali churches who are already doing ministry here.

<u>Please pray</u> that God would grow gospel ministry amongst Nepalese in Sydney. <u>Please pray</u> that God would show us the next step!
